

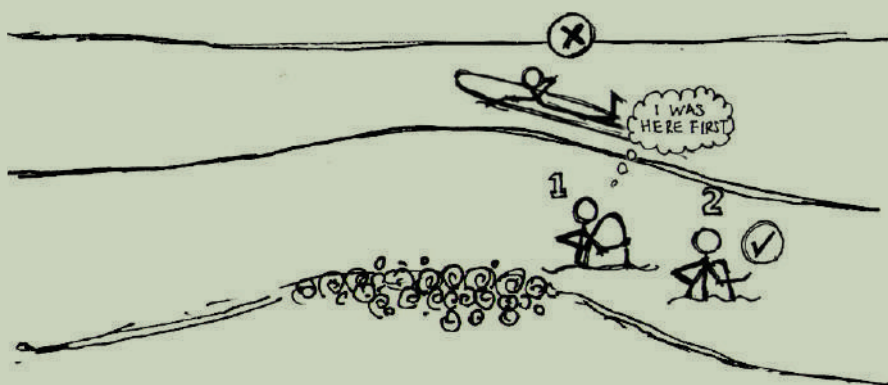
# Surf Etiquette.

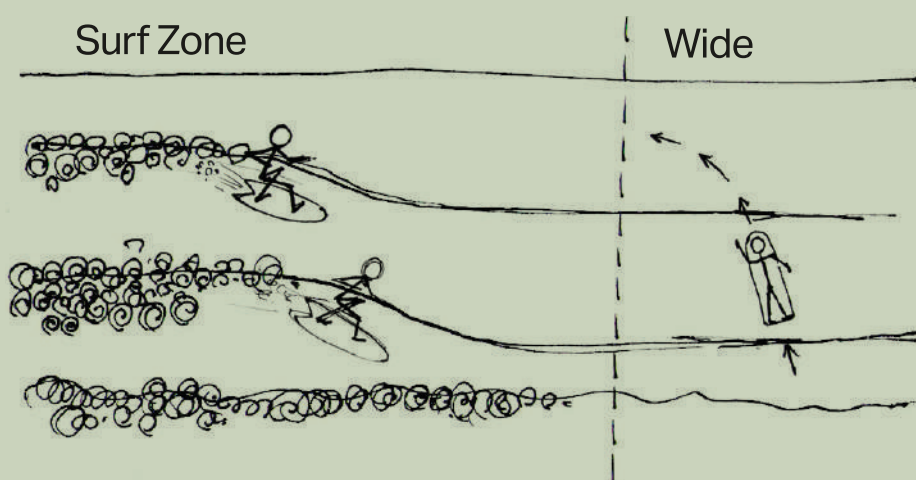
- 1 The surfer closest to the peak has right of way.



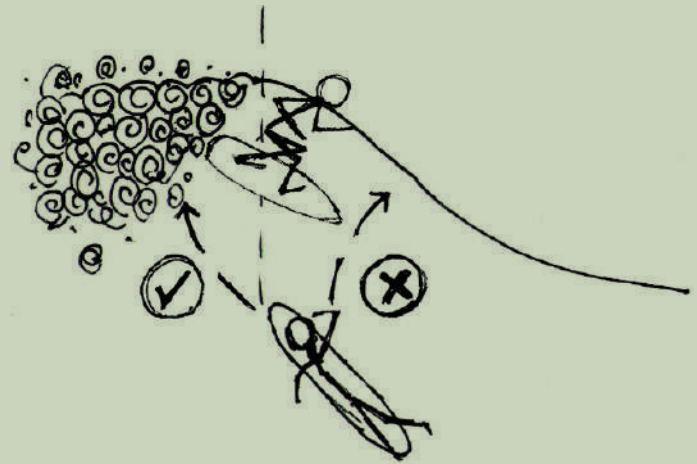
- 2 When surfing a peak, after your wave do not paddle back out past the other surfers waiting. Get to the back of the queue and wait your turn.



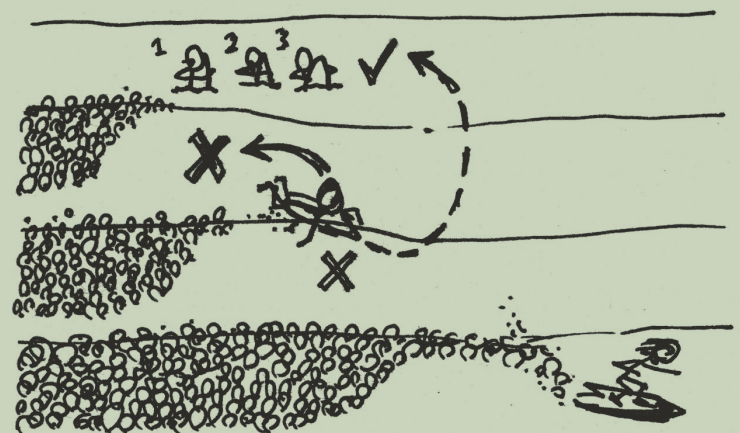
- 3 When paddling out don't go straight through the surf zone. Paddle wide to avoid interfering or colliding with another surfer.



- 4 If you are paddling back out and another surfer is riding a wave in front of you you must paddle for the white water NOT the shoulder, or open face of the wave. This allows the surfer to have a clear wave.



- 5 When surfing a peak or a pointbreak wave and it's your turn if you paddle for the wave and miss it you go to the back of the line.



- 6 Communicate with your fellow surfers, it's safer and, hey, it might even be fun!
